



## Marker Manufacturing Specifics

All memorial markers are to be of flat bronze. The bronze alloy used in the marker shall consist of not less than 87% copper and not more than 2 ½% lead.

Each marker should endure normal exposure to the elements without decomposition.

Available sizes for a full in ground burial space at Evergreen Memorial Gardens Cemetery is as follows:

Allowable children size: 16" x 8"

Allowable single sizes: 24" x 12" or 24" x 13"  
36" x 13" or 36" x 12"

Allowable companion sizes: 36" x 13" or 36" x 12"  
44" x 13" or 44" x 14"

Only one vase per marker allowed and only one marker per grave. However, companion markers may be centered over two spaces. A 44" marker will only be allowed over two spaces and must be a companion. The vase must be center mounted near the top. Sample shown below.

The average thickness of a marker should be not less than a fourth of an inch. The mounting bosses should be an integral part of the casting and large enough to be drilled and tapped for a 3/8 – 16 anchor. The letters are to be consistent in size and shape and buffed and highlighted.

Requirements for the installation of an outside seller/installer are listed on the following sheets.

All questions regarding the manufacture and/or installation of a marker should be addressed to the appropriate individual at the Evergreen Memorial Gardens Cemetery office. This will prevent unnecessary disappointment, expense, and delay to the family.
