Agnes Neil Thomson, known to all as "Nan," was born and raised in Glasgow, Scotland. She served in the Women's Forestry Service during World War II, and endured the bombing of Glasgow. Nan met James Bruce Speirs, "Bruce" while hiking in the highlands. They were married on July 3, 1943, and James Thomson "Jim" was born a year later. In 1949, Nan and Bruce immigrated to Canada, where Marjorie Anne was born. In 1952 they immigrated to the United States, where Ronald Bruce "Ron" was born. After raising their family in Paramus, NJ, Nan and Bruce retired to Palm Coast, FL, where Bruce passed away in 1996. Nan spent the last 12 years of her life in Vancouver, WA. Nan loved to knit, read, and work crossword puzzles. She was very social and retained friendships with people from each place where she lived. Nan is survived by her sons, daughter and her grand- children: Anne Zander, Gregory Speirs, Mara Zander Huebschman and Lauren Speirs; as well as Jim's wife, Dee Speirs, Ron's wife, Janice Speirs and Marjorie's husband, Bill Gross.
