Alan Michael Savage, age 80, went to his heavenly home on Wednesday, February 7, 2024, in Vancouver, Washington. Alan will be remembered for his strength of character, kindness and sense of humor.

Alan is survived by his wife of 43 years, Susan (Augee) Savage; brothers Eric Savage and John Savage of California; a step-daughter and step-son; 5 grand-children; and 2 great grand-children.

Alan was born in New York City, New York, in the borough of Queens. The family moved to southern California as he started grade school. He graduated from Newport Harbor High School and attended Orange Coast Community College in Costa Mesa. Alan loved sailing, surfing, the beach and the music of the 60's.

Early in his life Alan worked for phone companies in Southern California and on the Oregon Coast, and then in Eastern Oregon. While there he was Mayor of Pilot Rock, Oregon and owned a small acreage raising red angus cattle. In 1984, he began the printing and publishing company, American Eagle Enterprises, Inc, in Pendleton, Oregon. In 2020 the family moved to Washougal, Washington. For the last 10 years, after retiring from his business, Alan worked at Lowe's in East Vancouver, where he made many friends, co-workers and customers alike.
