Though I didn't expect I would be left anything because I never knew he had money until after his death, now that I know it did upset me. Some of it went to (2) churches which he despised when he was a young man. Dee and the lawyer likely thought it should go there and Andy was in no mental condition to decide otherwise. He was abused there as a child in one of the churches. He wouldn't have left them money had he been in his right mind. Some would think I wasn't his close friend for saying the truth here so openly, on the contrary. Andy loved truth. He often couldn't stand other people because they were dishonest. From that he was a recluse. A total loner. Come out only at night time all the years I knew him. He was clever, gentle and a great person. I sure miss his intelligence, his demeanor and his funny sense of humor. He lived to be 92 though his birth certificate said 85. He told me there was a fire years ago in the courthouse where records were kept and they never got it right and he never cared-much. But...he was 92. Take care Andy! I'll see you on the other side.
