September 2, 1927 - July 2, 2021

Andrew James Trammell, 93, of Vancouver, WA, peacefully passed away July 2, 2021, after a brief battle with pancreatic cancer.

Andrew was born Sept. 2, 1927 in Newnata, AR. One of 14 children that included two sets of twins. Andy being one of the second set.

On Dec. 11, 1945, at the age of 18, Andrew joined the United States Army and was stationed at Fort Lewis Washington as a Heavy Weapons Crewman (30 Caliber Heavy Machine Gun) and Marksman. He served with the Ninth Infantry Regiment until his honorable discharge July 28, 1947.

Andrew met his wife Beulah Pierce, as a teenager and they married May 22, 1948, in Mountain View, AR, going on to raise eight children. They recently celebrated their 73rd Wedding Anniversary.

Andrew worked several jobs throughout his life but considered himself a musician making several albums with his brother Daniel. The band played live music on the radio every Saturday evening in the 1950's and one time shared the stage with Country music legend, Little Jimmy Dickens.

After retirement Andrew continued singing, writing songs and playing his ever present 1959 Fender Stratocaster. He enjoyed Deep Sea Fishing, meeting friends for coffee, beach-combing and helping people in need. Andrew was

preceded in death by his parents, 12 siblings and one son, Andrew David Trammell.

He is survived by his wife, Beulah; and seven children, Elane Ruby (Jerry), James (Tillie), David, Kathy Lutz (Barry), Susan Witt, Hank (Kim), William, and Sheila Kiser; one sister, Dosha Gilbert; and 26 grandchildren.

Andy was a lifelong member of the Vancouver United Pentecostal Church.
