ANGELO PAUL DELLA July 26, 1926 ~ October 29, 2015 Angelo Della, 89, of Vancouver, WA, died Thurs., Oct. 29th, 2015 at Ray Hickey Hospice House at 7:05 a.m. with his wife at his side. He was born July 26th, 1926 in Walla Walla, WA, the youngest of five children of Michael and Anna Della, Italian Americans. Angelo was in the U.S. Navy during WWII serving on a troop transport ship as a radioman when he was honorable discharged in 1946. After the war, he attended the University of Portland attaining his degree in Education. He was a high school teacher for 34 years, retiring in 1989 from the Vancouver School District, teaching Business. Angelo is survived by his wife, Marie, of 55 years; his sons, Paul, David and Philip; daughter, Theresa McDougal; and four grandchildren, Morgan, Maddy, Victoria and Sophia. A Funeral Mass will be celebrated at Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Church, 4723 NW Franklin St., Vancouver, WA with FR. Woody McCallister presiding on Sat., Nov. 14, 2015. A rosary will be held at 10a.m. with the funeral starting at 11a.m., followed by a reception at the Gym next door. A graveside service will be held at Mother Joseph Catholic Cemetery at the corner of 29th and "N" St. in Vancouver, WA after the reception.
