ANNABELLE BAUMAN February 2, 1923 ~ August 26, 2014 AnnaBelle Bauman of Vancouver, WA, passed away on Aug. 26, 2014. She was the youngest child of Albert and Irene (Mason) Haller. She was born at home, 12 miles east of Woodland, WA, on Ground Hogs Day 1923. Her older siblings were brothers, Melville (2011), Robert (1981) and a brother that was lost as a toddler before her birth, Albert (aka "Little Man"). She is survived by her older sister, Margaret Colf Hepola. The Haller Family was one of many families displaced by the construction of Merwin Dam in 1929, and the children of displaced families became known as "water babies". AnnaBelle graduated from Woodland High School in 1941. She married Verne Bauman in 1947. Together they operated a successful business, Bauman's Egg Ranch, from 1955 until 1984. They also raised four children. Verne passed away December 2003. She had been a member of Woodland Baptist Church for almost four decades and loved to organize and be a part of "Junior Church", Good News Clubs, and their Nursing Home Ministry. AnnaBelle is survived by daughter, Gayle Bauman of Woodland, WA; son, Dennis Bauman of Bend, OR; nine grandchildren; and 10 great-grandchildren. She was preceded by her daughter, Diana Bauman Leathers (Jan. 2000); and son, Greg Bauman (May 2004).
