She attended Washington Grade School, Shumway Junior High, and Vancouver High School, where she graduated in 1943. Arlene worked summers in the shipyard and attended Washington State in Pullman, graduating in 1947. Arlene led an active life, leading a World Discussion Group and lunching with retired teachers. She was still driving until her final illness.
