Barbara Neff Barbara Ann (Burger) Neff, 81, died in her home on July 23, 2013. Born in Boulder, CO, she grew up there and received her B.A. degree from the University of Colorado, Boulder, in 1953. A week before graduation, she married John Lewis Neff, of Tulsa, OK. They settled in Spokane where John practiced law. Barbara was active in a variety of volunteer activities, PEO, the Spokane Public Library, on the board of Camp Fire Girls, active in Manito Methodist Church and busy with her daughters and their many activities.
