There she attended Meadow Glade Adventist Elementary and then Columbia Adventist Academy. Caroline had a kind, open heart for anyone and everyone, but above all else, she had a deep love for the Lord.

Caroline was brought up in a family bursting with music. Most Sabbath mornings she, and her sisters Ina and Elenor, could be found leading the congregation in a round of "Amazing Grace." As her music career progressed, Caroline sang at many events and venues, including the Memorial Coliseum in Portland, OR. In the '90s, she, with her sister Ina's accompaniment on piano, released her own Gospel album, "All Because of God's Amazing Grace."

In 1978 their lives were changed when Harold was involved in a construction accident rendering him a paraplegic. Nana" which she definitely was. She was a gifted hairstylist and together, with Harold, opened "The Second Look" beauty salon in Battle Ground, WA. She later obtained her real estate license where she had a successful career for over 20 years. One of Caroline's many gifts was that of hospitality. She hosted many church and family events and was always prepared for company.

Caroline passed away peacefully June 1, surrounded by friends and family. She touched many lives with her warm heart and sweet voice and will be greatly missed.
