Clarence C. Neumiller, 80, Vancouver, WA, passed away at home on March 31, 2010. He was born Sept. 28, 1929, near Heaton in Wells County, ND to John A. and Elizabeth Neumiller. Clarence attended country schools, worked on the farm for his family and several neighboring farmers before striking out on his own at a young age. Clarence became a heavy equipment operator, working primarily in the construction of several western U.S. interstate highways. He was a proud member of the Operating Engineers Union for 55 years. On June 4, 1951, Clarence married Ellen Morlock in Sykeston, ND. Clarence's work took them to seven western states as he followed road and dam construction projects. Together they provided a loving home for their four children. A life-long Lutheran, he was an active member wherever he was living. Clarence loved working on cars and engines and also enjoyed deer, chukkar and pheasant hunting. He loved to spend time with family and friends. Clarence is survived by his wife of 58 years, Ellen Neumiller; three daughters, Anita (Don) Maynor, Gail Oliver, LuAnn (George) Townsend; one son, Craig (Lynette) Neumiller; seven grandchildren; one great-granddaughter; two sisters, Frieda (Kenneth) Watson, Iola (Daryl) Rask; and one brother, Jacob (Kay) Neumiller. He was preceded in death by his parents, five brothers, eight sisters and five grandchildren.
