Connie was very active most her life. Enjoyed gardening her flowers which she did up to the days she passed. Was involved with the VFW, Eastern Stars, Auxiliary Ladies & Flea Club. She absolutely loved to travel and see as much as time would allow. Was always looking for the next fun adventure. Dancing and live music was her all time favorite thing to do. When she was 15 & 16 years old she told stories about going to the dance halls and dancing with all the soldiers during World War II. In her later years she met the love of her life Jim Black at the Eagles in Vancouver Wa. Who I know she's with now. She will be remembered.

She has chose to be cremated at the Evergreen Memorial Gardens In Vancouver Wa. Her final resting place will be along the side of Jim Black in the Willamette National Cemetery, Portland Or.
