Connie Morical died on Sept. 16 at her Vancouver home after a year-long bout with pancreatic cancer.

She was 72.

Connie was a beloved wife, mother, grandmother, sister, aunt, cousin and a dear friend to many. She enjoyed traveling, shopping, wine tasting, exercising and home decorating. Above all, she loved spending time with friends and family. Her laugh was contagious and occasionally uncontrolled. That laugh, her bright smile and her positivity would light up a room.

Connie was born March 10, 1951, in Loup City, NE. The daughter of a cattle buyer, Connie moved frequently throughout her youth, but spent most of her life in the Northwest, and lived for the last 21 years in Vancouver. She earned her associates degree from Spokane Falls Community College and worked in health care as a medical records technician for more than 30 years.

Connie married Steve Morical in 1975 and they were married for 48 years, raising three children, and enjoying eight grandchildren and five great-grandchildren. She was a devoted mother and grandmother who instilled in her children and grandchildren the passion to pursue their dreams and to always put family and friends first.

Connie faced her grave diagnosis in October 2022 with clear-eyed courage and determination. She never complained, but rather spent her final year surrounding herself with family and friends, even making a once-in-a-lifetime

trip to Paris.

Connie was adamant in her final days that she wanted a party, not a funeral. There will be a celebration of life for Connie on Sunday, Oct. 15, at 4 p.m. at the Heathman Lodge in Vancouver.

Connie was preceded in death by her father, Roy Stephens, and her mother, Bonnie Stephens. Connie is survived by her husband, Steve Morical; daughter, Cindy Morical; son, Mark Morical; stepson, Kirk Morical; grandchildren, Mason and Miley Morical; step-grandchildren, Ethan, Sarah, Kelli, Ayden, Iris and Arleigh Morical; and brother, Gary Stephens.
