Dawn Kristin Horner died peacefully the morning of November 20, 2022 ending an eight-year fight against Lung Cancer. Her loving family was by her side. Dawn was born in Lisbon, North Dakota to Donald & Dorothy Erickson. She married Greg Horner of Vancouver, Washington on September 1, 1990. Dawn was raised in Kirkland, Washington where she showed horses and played flute in the high school band. She attended Lake Washington High School and Bellevue Community College. Dawn was a trained x-ray technician, though she most valued her work raising three children. She was active in the classroom, at the dance studio and on the soccer field. In Felida, she is known for befriending newcomers, and neighbors will remember her walking the Salmon Creek Trail with her Jack Russell Terriers. Dawn enjoyed long distance running until she could run no further.

After her Lung Cancer diagnosis in 2014, Dawn made it her mission to advance research toward finding a cure. She was a fearless advocate and her impact on the Lung Cancer community is immeasurable. Dawn is survived by her husband, Greg; daughters Madison & Nicole; son Austin & wife Chloe; grandson, Hudson; mother, Dorothy and three siblings; Dan Erickson, Denise Nordi and Debbie Ashmun. Dawn is preceded in death by her father, Donald. Dawn found courage and peace through her faith in Jesus Christ.
