G. Dean Soule, 84, was born in Bozeman, Montana, the third of four brothers. The family moved to Vancouver, WA in the 1940's where he graduated from Vancouver High School in 1952. He married his high school sweetheart in 1953 and accepted a football scholarship at Oregon State University. In 1954 he transferred to Lewis & Clark college, where he became an All American football guard all while achieving a bachelor degree in education in 1956.

That same year he begun what would become a long career in teaching and coaching starting at Evergreen High School in Vancouver. In 1963 Dean moved his family to Lebanon Oregon to teach at the local high school and help raise his family of three kids.

In the early 1990's Dean was able to retire and start to enjoy his passions of travelling with his family, fishing, creating stain glass projects, and watching his kids and grand kids participate in athletics.

It is during this time that Dean started to become active in several senior softball leagues in the area. He built many strong friendships with his teammates, and always looked forward to attending the Senior World Games held in St. George, Utah. Over the past 17 years of participating, Dean and his team have brought home many gold medals for their age class.

Dean is survived by his wife, Doris L. Soule; son Rod Soule; daughters Rhonda Soule and Rechelle Soule; and four grandchildren, Jade, Garrett, Delanie and Porter; and two brothers, Ron and Dick Soule.
