Larry Jones was born March 24, 1932 in McVeigh, Kentucky, and left us August 7, 2023 in Battle Ground, Washington.

Larry moved to the Pacific Northwest with his family as a young boy and graduated from Evergreen High School in 1950. After time at Oregon State University and service during the Korean War, he purchased his farm north of Battle Ground in 1960. Farming was his love and he was a dairy farmer for many years.

His six kids were raised on that farm. He is survived by his daughters, Cari (Ernie) Jones of Naukati, Alaska, Devon (Michael) Stone of Camas, Washington, and Nena (John Lamoreau) Jones of La Grande, Oregon, and a son, Rand Jones of Malaga, Washington. Two sons, Kirby Jones and Aaron "Sparky" Jones, preceded him in death. He is also survived by his wife, Sue and three step-children, Kelley (Debi) Babcock of Battle Ground, Kerri (Rick) Harris of Battle Ground, and Kent (Sabrina) Babcock of Las Vegas, Nevada, and numerous, much loved, grandchildren, great-grandchildren, and two great-great-grandchildren.

Larry moved to Moses Lake in the mid 1990's where he continued his farming life. He moved back to the Battle Ground area in early 2022 for health reasons.
