He also taught Sunday School classes for children and Adults over the years. His final church home was Kessid here in Vancouver.

Don had several careers. As a teenager he worked at an auto body shop cleaning up and summers bailing hay. After coming to the NW, he was a checker for Montgomery Ward, Fred Meyer and Safeway where he also threw freight and managed the Dairy Department. He became a distributor for Clover Club Potato Chips selling chips and snacks to grocery stores in Idaho and then in Washington. For a time, he managed a limousine company and had fun taking several famous people out on the town. Between these jobs, he worked construction which became his final occupation. In addition to building and remodeling homes for others, Don purchased, remodeled and

sold many homes in the Vancouver area. He was "flipping houses" before it was cool!

Don loved to go camping, hunting and fishing. He was also a talented artist producing many beautiful oil paintings. He didn't think he was very good and would give away his paintings to anyone that wanted one.

Don was diagnosed with Parkinson's Disease at 50 years of age. This diagnosis was devastating, but he rarely complained. He continued to do the things he loved until he was not longer able to.

Don passed away at home on April 28th, 2022.

He is survived by his wife, Brenda; two sons Tom Langston (wife Cindy) and Jeremy Langston (wife Renee); five grandchildren, Nathon Charpiloz, Austin Dinsmore, Alex Langston, Kelly Langston and Kaylee Langston; two great-granddaughters, IzaBella Charpiloz and Macie Jo Phillips and soon to be born great-grandson Zaedyn Dinsmore.
