Dottie was primarily part of the Christian Reform Church as well as the Seventh-Day Adventist Church in Meadow Glade as well as in Phoenix. Dottie was happiest singing hymns in Church and could be heard singing around the house and was always smiling and welcoming to everyone. She made the best pies ever! Dottie loved her Dutch culture and looked forward to her monthly gatherings with the "Dutch Ladies" who gathered for amazing foods and conversations.

Dottie leaves behind 6 children, 16 grandchildren, and, 19 great grandchildren with her own 8 children. Dottie had numerous stepchildren and grandchildren with the Warner family of Ridgefield with her husband Bernie Warner who passed in 2006 in Phoenix. Bernie was a WWII Vet as well.
