Edward Page passed away on September 20, 2022, in Vancouver, WA at the age of 89 (one day short of 90). He was born in Redlands, CA and raised in San Bernadino, CA along with one sister, Dorothy. He attended Woodrow Wilson grade school, Arrow View Jr. High, and San Bernadino High school. He enrolled in football, basketball, and track. He also worked at his grandparent's orange ranch and worked 2 paper routes. At 17 he joined the army and was selected to join an elite special services group of 253. He served from 1949-1953 as a corporal in the Korean War. Following this he attended San Bernadino Junior College and University of Redlands then becoming an electrician for a short period. He had a partnership trucking company called H & H Trucking which he sold about 1980. He later became an owner/operator with leases to Interstate Trucking, Nestles, and Boise Cascade. He retired in 2004 after close to 50 years in the trucking industry. He always carried a bible on the road and talked the gospel over the CB and in restaurants. He was known for his smile and friendliness. He truly "Never Knew a Stranger". He went back to work for Custom Courier in 2005 because he missed contact with people. In 2011 a stroke caused him to retire permanently. He met his wife Patricia in 1987 and they married October 14, 1991. He was a member of Columbian Presbyterian Church in Vancouver, WA. Ed is survived by his wife, Pat and 3 children: Edward Page, Tracy

Garnand, and Curtis Page; 4 grandchildren: Jacob Garnand, Taryn Garnand Miller, Taylor Page, and Jason Page; 3 great grandchildren: Brady Miller, Zoey Miller, and Joel Denison. Also, his sister Dorothy Page Stamper and spouse Fred.
