



## Elizabeth Sork

November 5, 1916 - November 1, 2018

Elizabeth Temme was born on November 5, 1916 to William and Nora Temme in Geddes, South Dakota. She graduated from St. Ann's High School in 1934 and attended Notre Dame Jr. College in Mitchell, SD. She was a teacher in a one-room school house in Geddes for five years before moving to Vancouver in 1940. She worked at the C. C. Store for 36 years before retiring in 1976.

She married John J. Sork on April 19, 1963, and they made their home in Vancouver for the remainder of their lives. She was an avid seamstress and rosemaling artist. Many of her works of art are displayed at the Sons of Norway Lodge in Vancouver. Over the years she was active in paint clubs, the Sons of Norway, and Christmas bazaars. Some of her work has been featured in national artists' magazines. She often donated pieces to the Sons of Norway to use as a lodge fundraiser.
