



Elizardo Pineda Rosagaron

December 20, 1941 - July 15, 2024

12/20/1941-7/15/2024 82 years old Affectionately referred to as "Boy" Rosagaron. He was born to Teresa Pineda Rosagaron and Crisologo Rosagaron Sr. on December 20, 1941 in Caibiran Leyte, Philippines. He grew up in a big family and was 1 of 10 children. There was never a dull moment growing up. Boy was always the "ring leader" in the neighborhood and loved playing with his siblings and friends. He is survived by his two remaining sisters and one brother. He graduated Mapa High School in Manila, Philippines. In his early 20s, he joined the merchant marines as a sailor and traveled throughout Asia and part of Europe. He served on both Filipino and American ships. He finally settled in Portland, OR in the 1970s. His first marriage occurred in 1970 and in 1976 he became a naturalized citizen of the United States and shortly after, began his career at the Vancouver Steel Foundry Co. for about 15 years. He became a member of the Vancouver, WA/Portland, OR community and served as the first President of the Filipino American Association of Vancouver, WA. He re-married on December 12th, 1979 to his wife, Miguela Rosagaron. They worked hard to provide for their family and extended family. Boy was able to bring his brothers and sisters to the United States and make Vancouver, WA their home. Family was life. His hard work was always focused on providing for his family, he is survived by his three children, six grandchildren and one great grandchild. In 2001, he was diagnosed with kidney failure and in June of 2002 he received a new kidney through the organ donor program. He officially retired from full time work in

2004 and shortly after that, he began employment at the Vancouver Seafarer Center, Port of Vancouver, as a driver/tourguide for the men and women that come into the port, coming "full circle" from the start of his time as a merchant marine. He truly enjoyed this work and did it for many years until his health began to decline in 2020. During his last hospitalization, Boy took his last breath with his wife and grandson Anthony by his side. God is with him in that moment, may he rest in peace with our Lord Jesus Christ in the eternal life.
