Flordelina “Linda” Guillermo Sabado, 72, of Camas, Washington, passed away peacefully on November 13, 2025 at Ray Hickey Hospice House. Linda was born in the City of Laoag of Ilocos Norte province, Philippines, to Quirino and Maria Guillermo on March 7, 1953. She was the youngest of six siblings.
