



## Gary John Fischer

February 9, 1940 - August 15, 2016

On August 15, 2016 Gary John Fischer passed away 18-months after being diagnosed with bile duct cancer. He was surrounded by his immediate family. Gary was born in a small house in Fern Prairie, WA on February 9, 1940. He was the 4th son born to Lloyd and Margaret Fischer. He attended Camas High School and worked on the Fischer family farm as well as the Camas Papermill. In 1958 Gary was drafted into the Army and sent to Germany, where he served for 2 years. No matter who you were, Gary treated you like family. He was a kind spirit, caring, supportive, happy and always making everyone around him smile and laugh, either with a funny joke, a silly story of the past or from a good tickle.
