Gay Robert Lincoln passed away April 30. He was born Feb. 8, 1940, in Kearny, NE, to Lester and Marjorie (Lewis) Lincoln.

Gay graduated from East High School in Salt Lake City, UT. He served in the United States Marine Corps from 1958 - 1962. He worked in the airline industry for 39 years.
