Geraldine Louise (Luokkala) Sullivan, known as "Jerry", passed away at Angelbrook Estates in Vancouver, Washington on March 7 at 10:25 P.M.. She was born Geraldine Louise Worley on April 8, 1924 in Ness City, Kansas. A few years later the family moved to Washington state. After graduating from R.A. Long High in Longview, Jerry enlisted in the United States Marine Corps with her brother Harold and became a WWII veteran. She met Oscar Luokkala at a dance and they married in 1947. They had three children. Jerry was the last Worley sibling, preceded in death by 5 brothers - Harry, Herman, Joseph, Harold, Clarence and 5 sisters - Grace, Ethel, Blanche, and Marie.
