



Glen Roger Witherbee

February 4, 1950 - May 30, 2021

Glen "Roger" Witherbee passed away on Sunday May 30th, 2021 at Elder's Nest Family Care Center in Battle Ground, Washington. At the time of his passing, Roger resided in Vancouver, Washington with his wife of 45 years. Roger leaves behind his wife Geraldine Witherbee and his four children Kimberly Wright, David Perrault, Nicholas Witherbee, and Linsey Witherbee, and Roger's sixteen grandchildren, two great grandchildren and many nieces and nephews.

Roger was brought in to this world by Walter Witherbee and Ruby Clark on February 4th, 1950 in Glasgow, Montana. He was the second youngest of four children, three siblings who survive him, Walter Witherbee, Jeannie Chagrin, and Lynn Pacheco.

Roger really enjoyed surrounding himself with close friends and family. His best times were anything he could do with his wife, kids and grandkids. He retired from the Washington State Department of Transportation at the end of 2000 and spent his time with family and friends. Roger was always ready for adventures. He loved animals and time in the outdoors. He liked to take in scenery, hiking and swimming, and maintained those activities as long as he could. Roger's kidneys begin failing in 2008. He eventually was able to get a transplant, giving us another many blessed years with him. He battled with complications with diabetes and renal failure. He passed away at the age of

71. It is with great sadness that we say goodbye to him, husband, father, brother, grandfather, uncle and friend.

Roger had not wanted a funeral service at the end of his life. With all of the complications of the pandemic for the last year, he wanted his family to celebrate his life in an intimate setting. His wish was to be buried at the Finley-Crawfordsville Cemetery outside of Brownsville, Oregon.
