



## Harry Edward LeClaire

February 4, 1942 - March 11, 2017

Harry Edward LeClaire (Ed LeClaire), age 75, passed away Saturday, March 11, 2017 at Community Home Health and Hospice in Vancouver, Washington. Ed was born on February 4, 1942 in Menlo Park, California, to Harry and Norma LeClaire. He graduated from Menlo Park High School in 1960 and Oregon State University in 1964. Ed worked as the President of the Electronic Office Products Division of Tab Products in Palo Alto, California for 20 years. Ed then became the founder and CEO of a company named Edible Technology where he invented his "Anytime Pizza Machine." In 1990, he moved this company to Vancouver, Washington, where he put this product into production. Ed managed this business in Vancouver until his retirement in 2000, when he sold the manufacturing rights of the Anytime Pizza Machine.
