At Concordia she was very active in Christian Life Ministries, and was a CLM Peer Minister. Hope dearly loved her time at Camp Lutherwood, and achieved her goal of being a summer camp counselor. Hope was a counselor two years at Camp Lutherhaven in Idaho, and one year at Camp Lutherwood in Oregon. Hope had a goal of making a difference in the world. If she made a difference in your life, I would love to hear about it. It would be nice if others carried on her goal by making a difference with their lives.
