Vancouver loses a piece of its history. James "Jim" Court was born in Vancouver, WA. He passed away from natural causes at the age of 93. Jim experienced the Great Depression when you couldn't afford a haircut, had no shoes, wore clothes made from flour sacks and walked miles to school and back in all weather conditions. He attended Battle Ground High School where he lettered in varsity football. He served in WWII with the U.S. Army, 63rd Infantry Division, and fought in the Battle of the Bulge, earning a Bronze Star. Jim was married over 50 years to Larissa Court who passed away in January 2009. He will be fondly remembered as an honest man of high integrity, an avid fisherman and devoted patriot. He was a lifetime member of the American Legion, 40 et 8 and Veteran's of Foreign Wars. Jim is survived by his three children: Launa Marie Cone (first marriage), James A. Court and Gregory P. Court; and several grandchildren and great-grandchildren.
