His more common nickname was "Bird"-because as a baby he would flap his arms like a bird while on the floor, so this developed his nickname and set forth what he was good at loving all animals. Birds Birds would come land on him. A white dove landed on his shoulder-while he was in the barn. His Parakeets would land on each hand while he would dance with his hands to the song "Back to the Hotel" song. He loved Dogs and Cats

James was a free spirit marching to His own Drum. As a young boy in HeadStart, he wanted to go see grandma and grandpa who lived next to the school.
