Jim Hughes, 50, of Vancouver, WA died unexpectedly in his sleep on Tuesday, January 5, 2021 at the home of his father Ronald Hughes.

Born on January 3, 1971 in Syracuse, NY, Jim was the youngest child of Ronald and Agatha (Fediuk) Hughes. Jim was a 1988 graduate of Christian Brothers Academy in Syracuse, NY and pursued his degree in Criminal Justice at Utica College and State University of New York at Buffalo. Upon completing college, he worked in credit collections for Ingram Micro in Buffalo, NY and Baltimore, MD.

Although Jim had a life-long battle with diabetes, he always managed to make the best of it. He was a big-hearted person that loved his family and was especially proud of his son, Sean. He had a great sense of humor and was happy to recently spend time with his father in Washington where they enjoyed daily walks filled with jokey banter. An avid sports fan, Jim was rarely seen without his Denver Broncos hat. In his younger days, he played soccer and competed in swimming. He also enjoyed traveling and trying interesting local fare. He had a favorite chili crab restaurant in Singapore, where he studied abroad during high school, and also enjoyed squid pie. In Buffalo, he liked the original wings at the Anchor Bar and loved to bring home buckets of Kimchi from an Asian market.

Jim is survived by his son, Sean Hughes of Baltimore, MD; father Ronald Hughes of Vancouver, WA; and five siblings: Mark (Penny) Hughes of LaVale, MD; Michael (Dawn) Hughes of Greensboro, NC; Patrick (Mary) Hughes of Milwaukee, WI; Mary Hughes of Salem, OR; and Louiza (Sean) Bhogadia of Staples, MN.

He was preceded in death by Agatha Hughes on July 24, 1993.

There will be no funeral mass at this time due to the coronavirus pandemic. A service will be held at a future date for family and friends.
