Her love of classical music was instilled in all her children.

She was feisty, strong willed, and kept us all on our toes. She loved the fall season with its beautiful autumn leaves and rich colors. She loved stormy skies where trees "danced in the wind," and the clouds that were dark and dramatic. She loved the deep blue skies as well, with puffy cumulus clouds.

She is infamous for her "Pink Cloud" story where she would gather all the children around to tell it impromptu while including every child listening. She later went on to publish this story under the title, "An Unusual Journey".

We are grateful for the time we got to spend with Mom in her last weeks, and we will never forget the kindness of her caregivers and hospice team.

Janet was born in New York. She lived briefly in Indiana with her mother and sister. She graduated High School and went to work in a bank. She married Patrick Rogers and had one child named Anne. Later she moved to California to start a new life and be near her sister. After working in a factory for a year,

Janet decided to go to college and earned a teaching degree. She then decided to accept a position teaching first grade in Gold Beach, Oregon where she met and married Harold Lange. They then moved to Hemlock, WA., the foundation for our love of nature and mom's favorite place amongst the huge maples and firs. Janet and Harold had three children, Taryn, Mark and Cheryl. Sadly, Harold passed on February 6, 2004, just shy of their 40th wedding anniversary on Valentine's Day, but now they are together again!
