



## Jesse E. Orellano-Leister

July 26, 1993 - November 17, 2013

Jesse Enrique Orellano-Leister was born in Vancouver on July 26, 1993, and died at the hand of a drunk driver on November 17, 2013, also in Vancouver. He was 20 years old. Jesse put his entire being into his passions and had no use for the mundane. He battled ADHD all his life and Type I diabetes from the age of 7. He was goofy, loveable and charismatic. No matter where Jesse went, people noticed him and were smitten by his infectious grin and love of fun. One of Jesse's passions was music and he devoted himself to mixing tracks and DJ'ing at raves. He was eager to expand his abilities and wanted to study at Clark College. Jesse was making a name for himself as DJ Rapt3r, and recently remarked that he could "die happy now" when he had an opportunity to perform with one of his idols. He was actively involved with DanceSafe, an educational organization dedicated to providing accurate drug information to young people. Jesse is survived by his mother Janet Leister, brother Christopher Larsen, grandmother Rita Leister, stepfather Daniele Barbero, uncle Steven Leister, all of Vancouver, aunt Theresa Anderson of La Center, cousins Logan Leister, Kristin McCloone and Rick Anderson, stepsister Jody Barbero, and special friend Kayla Klingenfuss.
