John Hope, who lived in Vancouver, Washington for 27 years, died on September 17. He was 73 years old. John was born in Boston on June 28, 1936. He retired from serving the United States Government in North Island, San Diego. His service included work abroad as a member of STRAAD (Special Techniques for Repair and Assessment of Aircraft Damage) during the Vietnam War.
