**JONATHAN JOSEPH PATTERSON** Jonathan Joseph Patterson, 22, went to be with the Lord peacefully on March 28, 2017, at home, surrounded by friends and family. Jonathan was born on May 23, 1995 in Portland, OR to Gordon and Carrie Patterson. He was home schooled in his early years and graduated from Academy Northwest in 2014. He was enrolled at the Clark County Skills Center in the pre-engineering and computer technology programs. Jonathan attended Clark College as a graphic design major and worked at the library as well as on the literary publication, The Phoenix. He was diagnosed with Acute Myeloid Leukemia in May 2017 and had to withdraw from classes, but continued to design comics and write stories. Jonathan was involved in Whole Armor Martial Arts, 4-H, and Christian Youth Theater. He achieved the AWANA Citation Award and was a camp counselor for Puget Sound Camp during the summer prior to his illness. Jonathan is survived by his mother, Carrie; brother, Caleb; and sister, Julia. He was preceded in death by his father, Gordon. A Celebration of Life will be held on April 21, 2018 at 2 pm at First Evangelical Church, 4120 St. Johns Rd., Vancouver, WA.
