Our dad, grandpa, great-grandpa, great-great-grandpa, uncle and friend departed his earthly life while at his home with his daughter and son-in-love by his side. Joe was the eighth and last child of Madison and Anna Dyer. He was born in Butte, MT, in 1934 and moved to Vancouver in the early 50's. He met the love of his life, Marie Pitts, in 1953, and they were married in 1954. They welcomed their first child, Joe Jr., in 1955. Their daughter, Linda Marie, followed in 1956.

Joe went to work at SP&S railroad and enjoyed a long career of 45 years. He made many lifelong friends during those years. They enjoyed bowling teams, softball and company picnics.

He retired in 1995 from BNSF to enjoy life with his beloved wife, of 49 years, Marie, and their dog, Shauna.

In 2018, Joe sold his home and moved onto his daughter and son-in-love's property to be closer to his family and enjoy the care and assistance of Linda and Randy. He loved watching the birds and squirrels from his window. Joe loved working puzzles and paint by number on his notebook. He loved spending time with his family and watching them all grow up. Joe was preceded in death by his wife, Marie, in 2003; his son, Joseph Jr., in 2015; and his youngest daughter, Julie Mae in 1958.

He was also preceded by seven siblings and their spouses, 12 in-laws and 11 of their spouses. He was the sole survivor of his generation, other than a sister-in-law, Judy Pitts.

Joe is survived by his daughter and son-in-love, Linda and Randy Lindauer; three granddaughters, Kymberly, Lindy, and Summer; two grandsons, Sean and Billy Joe; five great-granddaughters; five great-grandsons; four great-great-granddaughters and two great-great-grandsons; numerous nieces and nephews on his side and Marie's side of the family.

Funeral services will be at Evergreen Memorial Gardens Chapel Friday, March 15, at 3 p.m. There will be a viewing prior to the service from 2 till 2:50 p.m.
