Joyce Williams of Vancouver passed away Aug. 2, 2021, at the age of 88. She was born March 12, 1933, in San Francisco to Oliver and Margaret Lundborg. Joyce was very proud of her San Francisco heritage and shared many stories of growing up with family and friends in the city she loved. Her one claim to fame was taking her "first steps" as a child on Alcatraz Island.

After Albert's passing in 1988, Joyce took up Bunko, became a hospital volunteer for 12 years, enjoyed her Thursday pizza lunches with her lady friends and participated in her AA meetings, having proudly achieved 38 years of sobriety.

Joyce was preceded in death by her parents, Oliver and Margaret Lundborg; and her husband, Albert. She is survived by her son, Michael (Christy); and daughter, Lisa Fish (Charlie); six grandsons and five great-grandchildren.
