Katherine "Kay" Evelyn Warner passed away peacefully on December 9, 2018, in Vancouver Washington with family by her side.

She was born in Yakima, Washington to Archie and Nellie Sanborn on October 26, 1922. A graduate of Yakima High School and the University of Washington, Kay taught school in Yakima and Seattle.

Kay married Lloyd Warner on June 13, 1948. Lloyd was employed by the U.S. Forest Service, and several of their first homes were at remote ranger stations. In 1963, they moved to Vancouver and had lived in the same house since 1964.

After their children were born, Kay became a very busy stay at home mom. She was active in PTA, many different church groups, volunteered at Share House, and headed the quilting group at Glenwood Community Church for many years. She and Lloyd exercised regularly at the YMCA, after which they always enjoyed a donut and coffee with several workout friends. A lifelong committed Christian, Kay was instrumental in organizing Christian service groups, vacation bible schools, and Sunday Schools wherever they lived.

She was preceded in death by her husband Lloyd last May, her parents, and an older brother whom she adored, Arnie Sanborn.

Kay is survived by three children, Carol (David) Kelley, Beth (Randy) Grambo and Ross Warner; nine grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.
