Having endured the effects of 8 years from Alzheimer's disease, Kay received loving care every day. Kay received her education in Moscow, Idaho. She and her future husband, Wayne DeWitt, were high school sweethearts, marrying in 1948 at the age of 19-20. She worked for the Navy reserve where she received a special government award, and was also awarded a PHT from the University of Idaho (putting her husband through college). After college, Kay and her husband lived on the East Coast, Midwest, and West Coast, finally settling in Vancouver, Washington for the last 52 years. She was a wonderful wife and mother to her husband, son, and daughter, contributing hours and days to Girl Scouts and the Little League board. Kay bowled for 32 years with 3 other friends, was a good golfer (others when golfing with her always enjoyed her hip shake just prior to teeing off) and loved to garden. She had a special talent of writing poems. Kay sold real estate in the 1970's until in 1979 when Wayne and her started a heavy construction business where Kay served as the Chief office person, and continued in that position for 15 years. The company needed her for its success. Kay was deeply loved, giving forth the same to all family and friends. She leaves behind a husband of 68 years, Wayne; son, Tyler DeWitt (Teri); daughter, Shelly Speyer (Greg); five strapping grandsons; and three

great-grandchildren. She is and will be continually deeply missed. The good Lord has received a wonderful, loving person and sure He is glad to have her.
