She cherished life's adventures from traveling around the world, chasing hot air balloons, and helping make her children and grandchildren's lives a little easier.

She leaves behind a profound legacy, marked by seven children, 14 grandchildren, and four beautiful great-granddaughters. Though she is no longer physically with us, Kathy's love, faith, and spirit live on in the hearts of those who knew her. She will be deeply missed but never forgotten.
