



## Kathryn Delores Kreller

October 5, 1923 - April 18, 2010

Kathryn Delores Kreller, passed away at home on Sunday, April 18, 2010 at 11:00 a.m. after a long battle with lymphoma. She was 86 years old. Kathy was born on October 5, 1923 in the small town of Hawarden, Saskatchewan on the Canadian prairie. She was the only child of Thomas D. Hickey and Flora A. Burns. As a young adult Kathy moved to Saskatoon and during World War II she worked welding on Bren gun carriers. Sometime after the war she met Richard Kreller at the boarding house where she was living. In 1953 she followed him to Vancouver, WA and they were married on October 31. They were together for over 56 years. Kathy and Dick raised two children, Tom and Barb, and in 1975 they purchased the Bresler's Ice Cream Shop in what was then Tower Mall. She worked the shop with her kids and a variety of other employees for over 14 years before retiring. She and Dick enjoyed travelling, taking several cruises, and trips to visit relatives in Canada. Kathy is survived by her husband, Richard, children Thomas Kreller (and Kristi) and Barbara Erickson (and Don), and grandchildren Andrea Kreller, Jessica Buchanan, Stacy Kozlowski, and Justin Kreller. Kathy was a wonderful wife, mother, grandmother and friend. She was dearly loved and her passing leaves an empty spot in our lives. We will miss her greatly.
