



## Kathy J Hardman

October 28, 1949 - June 19, 2022

Kathy Jean (Fulford) Hardman, of Vancouver, Washington, formerly of Los Angeles, California, passed away at her home on June 19, 2022. She was 72.

Born in Los Angeles, she spent her early childhood on both the east and west coasts until her parents settled down in a suburb north of LAX. She lived in Los Angeles for much of her life, and pursued a degree in political science at UCLA. In the 80s she married Stanley Hardman and welcomed two children. Initially she was a stay-at-home mother, but in the 90s she became an office manager at an aerospace company. After retiring, she relocated to Washington state to be closer to family and the beautiful Pacific Northwest. She loved her garden, her home, opera and classical music, good books, American history, classic cars, and her independence.

She was predeceased by both parents, Harry Fulford and Norma (Sandall) Fulford, as well as an infant sister Susan. Her ex-husband, Stanley Hardman, also predeceased her. Though not married at the time of his death, they parted this world as very good friends.

She is survived by her sister, Candy (Lanny) Carlson, as well as son Travis Hardman, daughter Lindsay (Marc) Yousey, her grandchildren, and many, many nieces and nephews.
