Kirk Edward Frazier 67, of Vancouver, Wa. passed away peacefully at home on April 15, 2025. He was born in Woodbury, New Jersey, to Vivian and Jack Frazier on August 15, 1957. While growing up in New Jersey, Kirk enjoyed adventures with his three brothers, wrestling, visits to the shore, and trips to see family in Florida.

As a teenager, Kirk hitchhiked across the country with a friend and discovered the West. He spent some time at Slippery Rock State University in Pennsylvania before moving west permanently. Stops in the west included studying photography at Montana State University, beginning a career in Sales in Seattle, and eventually settling in Vancouver with his young family. Along the way he explored many interests and took on numerous projects, including the purchase and complete renovation of a 1906 vintage home. A lover of the outdoors, Kirk found joy in hiking, fishing in quiet waters, bird watching, and tending to his yard with care. While hiking, Kirk was known to pause along the trail to pick up litter-an act that spoke volumes about his commitment to preserving the environment. He recycled diligently and made conscious efforts to reduce his ecological footprint. Kirk also enjoyed listening to music, reading, and tackling home projects.

Always a storyteller, Kirk was known for his long detailed stories and often laughed the loudest at the punchline. In recent years, he held a special place in his heart for his great-nieces, great-nephews, and neighbor children and loved sharing jokes with them. He demonstrated a 'goofy' sense of humor and

loved pranks with his children.

Kirk faced life's challenges with remarkable determination. He battled cancer three times with unwavering courage and strength. Throughout the battle he embraced a steady diet of jogging and lengthy gym workouts. Despite personal hardships, Kirk remained quick to help others in need and did not hesitate to initiate conversations with strangers.

May Kirk's memory bring comfort to those who knew him and serve as a reminder of the quiet power of kindness, perseverance, and care for both people and the planet.

He is survived by his wife, Diane; daughter, Audrey; son, Eli; and brothers Kevin (Kim); and Jeff (Machiko). He was preceded in death by his parents and his brother, Jack.
