



## Kun H. Cho

June 25, 1934 - June 20, 2022

Kun Ho Cho, a retired pastor, died peacefully at his daughter's home in Vancouver, WA, on June 20, 2022, at the age of 87.

Kun Ho is survived by his wife, Ki Nam Cho; his younger sister, Wook Ja Cho; his children, James and Claire Cho, Esther and Jeremy Liu, and Dan and Tasha Cho; his grandchildren, Elena and Ally Anunciado, and Emmanuel, Luran, Adena, Madeline, Keaton, and Elinor Cho. He is predeceased by his mother, Oh Hyun Min, father, Jae Jin Cho, and older brother Chul Ho Cho.

Kun Ho was born in Tokyo, Japan, on June 25, 1934, to Oh Hyun Min and Jae Jin Cho. Shortly after his birth, his family moved back to Korea, their country of origin, where he attended Sahmyook Adventist University to become a pastor.

In 1965, he married his wife, Ki Nam Cho, and together, had three children, James, Esther, and Dan. In October of 1978, he and his wife immigrated to the U.S. in hopes to provide their children with a better education. They first moved to New York City, and then later on to Chicago, Indianapolis, Minneapolis, Anchorage, and finally settled in Vancouver, WA.

As a pastor, he was passionate about his ministry and spreading God's word. Sociable, friendly, and outgoing, he never failed to crack a joke and bring a

smile to those around him. He was energetic, active, loved sports (particularly speed skating in his earlier years), and had a keen navigational/directional sense - especially helpful for the many visits he made as a pastor to those in need. As a choir conductor, he was also passionate about music, and always held the tune of a hymn under his breath. His smile and lively spirit will be deeply missed by his friends, family, and all who knew him.
