Lenore Ann (Warren) Taylor, age 91, of Vancouver, Washington, passed away peacefully on October 12, 2024, in her hometown. She was preceded in death by her parents, Robert and Katherine Warren; her husband, Lloyd R. Taylor; her son, Lloyd A. Taylor; and her brother, Larry Warren, and his wife, Patty. She is survived by five of her children: Jim (Karen), Glen (Joyce), JoAnn, Shari, and Terry, as well as her daughter-in-law, Debbie. Lenore's greatest joy was family. She cherished family reunions, holidays, visits with her children and grandchildren, watching all the grandkid's sports games, as well as vacations with her siblings.
