Lester "Les" Albert Woodman, Sr., 96, formerly of Washougal, WA, died on Jan. 23, 2011. He was born in Florence, OR to Harrison and Bertha (Green) Woodman and raised in Washougal. Survivors include his daughters, Janette Smith and JoAnn "Suzy" (Andy) Listy; his son, Tim (Diane); his brother, Cliff; daughters- in-law, Patty, Janis and Bobbi; 24 grandchildren; 28 great-grandchildren; two great-great-grandchildren; and many more relatives and friends. He was preceded in death by his parents; both wives; infant daughter, Joyce; three sons, Mike, John and Les, Jr.; and two sisters, Nellie Dahlgren and Dottie Ast-Aslin.
