



## Lionel Millard Livermore

February 27, 1925 - July 7, 2016

Lionel M. Livermore passed away July 7, 2016 at the age of 91. He was born in 1925 to Millard P. and Hazel M. Livermore (Loiselle) in Cornell, Wisconsin and moved with family to California in 1936. After graduation from Herbert Hoover High School in Glendale, California Lionel enlisted in the Navy and was stationed at Whidbey Island, Washington where he worked in air traffic control. In 1945 Lionel married Jean Griffith in Woodland, Washington where they later lived and raised their family. Lionel is survived by his children Shelley Stoll (Robert), Scott Livermore, Tamara Duemmer (Werner), Tracy Thomas (James), and Craig Livermore (Dawn), grandchildren Nicholas Thomas, Stephanie Thomas Smith, and Matthew Livermore, five great-grandchildren, and his sister Claire Marlowe. His wife Jean preceded him in death. Lionel taught at R.A. Long High School and Lower Columbia College in Longview, Washington. His higher education background included Western Washington University, Oregon State University, and Reed College. He was involved in the planning of OMSI and school science fairs. Lionel was an educator committed to learning, outstanding scholarship, and providing inspiration to students and colleagues. He valued his friendship with Dr. Linus Pauling and was an active American Chemical Society member. Lionel served on the Woodland School District School Board and was a long time member of the Woodland Presbyterian Church.
