



Lloyd Ambrose Dearey

May 10, 1916 - February 8, 2011

A Clark County resident for over 60 years, Lloyd A. Dearey, 94, passed away on Feb. 8, 2011 at the Ray Hickey Hospice House in Vancouver, WA, surrounded by his children and son-in-laws. Lloyd served his country in the U.S. Navy during WW II. He was a Charter lifetime member of The Knights of Columbus and was one of the first parishioners of St. Joseph Catholic Church.
