Shortly after he met and married the love of his life Marion Jean Davis. They lived in Mississippi, North Carolina, Alabama, back to Mississippi, before finally moving to Washington. They were married 49 years. Louis was an Electrician for many years, before his disability took hold, and before surrendering to a call to be a missionary in the state of Washington, serving and reaching homeless people through a food bank in the Vancouver area. Louis is survived by his wife, Marion Swartz, his five sons, Raymond and Beverly Swartz of Brandon, MS, Scott Swartz of Vancouver, James and Tonya Swartz of Petal, MS, Benjamin Swartz of Vancouver, Joseph and Jennifer Swartz of Clackamas, OR, and his eight grandchildren, Brittany Marie, Shelby Faye, Maggi, Danielle, Maycee, Joey, Jackson, and Stella. Louis is also survived by his sister and two brothers, Claud and Margaret Stafford of Hattiesburg, MS, Ricky and Dianne Swartz and Leon and Kathy Swartz of Mooresville, NC. He is also survived by his aunt JC and Mae Jennings of Cartersville, GA, and a host of nieces, nephews, and cousins that he loved and cared for dearly. Louis is preceded in death by his parents, Louis and Neola, and several Aunts and Uncles. Louis had a Celebration of Life service on April 26th at Brush Prairie Baptist Church
