Her parents and siblings, Helen, Irene, Leonard, Harry, Ray and Clarence have all preceded her in death. Lue attended and graduated from Ridgefield High School in 1940. During her school years, she attended Salmon Creek Lutheran Church which later became St. Johns Lutheran Church. After graduation, Lue went to work for Andys Auto Repair Shop where she worked mainly in the office but was also called upon to pick up automotive parts. She also worked part-time for Mode-O-Day in downtown Vancouver and the CC Store. Lue met Collin Brigham while working for Andys Repair Shop and married in 1946 at Memorial Lutheran Church. Together they had one child, Donald. Collin brought two small boys into this marriage, Leonard and Tom. Later in life, she met and married George Zupan in 1964. They lived in the Fruit Valley area until his death in 1994 due to a stroke. Lue went to work for the Vancouver School District in 1970 until 1987 working with special needs children where she retired from. Lue has been a longtime member of Memorial Lutheran Church and was so grateful for all the friends she made while attending. Lue leaves behind her three sons, Donald, Leonard (Gloria) and Tom (Lynn); three granddaughters; eight great-grandkids; and numerous nieces and nephews.
